




# How to Form the Passive • To be + Past Participle Reg. verb = V+ED Irr. Verb : 3rd C. paradigm

### From Active to Passive Sentence

 Rules: the object of the active sentence becomes subject in the passive sentence
 The subject of the active sentence becomes object in the passive sentence (or is left out)

















## Use of Passive

- Passive voice is used when the focus is on the action.
- Example: My bike was stolen.
- Sometimes a statement in passive is more polite than active voice
- Example: A mistake was made

In this case, I focus on the fact that a mistake was made, but <u>I do not blame anyone (</u>e.g. You have made a mistake.)





# **By-Agent**

- We are normally not interested in the "doer" of an action in a passive sentence.
- When we want to mention the "doer", we use the preposition by.
- Example: The house was built by Mr Brown
- When we do not know, who was the "doer" of the action, we use someone or somebody in the active sentence. We leave out these words in the passive sentence.

Example: Someone stole my bike. (active) My bike was stolen. (passive)
